From the Principal:

Welcome Back for Semester 2

I hope all our families had an eventful, adventurous, uplifting, relaxing or a 'whatever you needed' break from school. We have some serious learning planned along with some fun-filled events for both the children and adults in our Bell community. Here is a taste of things to come this term:

- I am looking forward to my first Bell Trivia night on *Friday 3 August*...lots of dancing, singing, laughing and a bit of trivia too I believe;
- More sport for our older students with District Basketball on Wednesday 8 August;
- An athletics experience for all students at Bell with a Grade 4-6 Carnival at Coburg Athletics Track on *Friday 10* August. Then a Prep-Grade 3 Mini-Aths event here at school led by our student leaders in the week afterwards (date to be confirmed);
- Swimming rolls on this term with the Grade 2s starting their six-week program from *Thursday 9 August*. Grade 1s will be the final grade level to dip into the pool during term 4;
- Selected students in the older year will represent our school at the District Athletics on *Monday 10 September*.

Keep an eye on the 'Important Dates' section below as the term progresses, and please keep those notes and money (or preferably Qkr!) coming in by the due dates.

Organisation at Bell in the Mornings

At assembly on Monday, we will be reminding students about expectations when the 8.50am bell goes each morning to prompt everyone it is time to head towards class ready for a 9.00am start. This means:

- It is time to stop ball games and other play activities, and think about the learning day ahead;
- Go to the toilet before entering the classroom so there are no requests soon after learning starts;
- Fill your water bottle on the way;
- Unpack your bag and set up your table for your first session;
- Then have a chat to your classmates and teacher before launching into another curious day at Bell.

We ask parents who accompany their child/ren to support this daily routine which helps us in developing independent and resilient learners.

Mid-Year Reports

Staff have completed student reports that summarise Semester 1 learning achievements and detail some focuses for future growth over Semester 2. These reports are currently being printed after working though a final moderation process, and will be sent home next Friday for parents/students to read and celebrate success so far. Student-led conferences will be conducted later in Term 3 in a similar format to last year. More details about the conference will be published in up-coming newsletters. Meanwhile, if there is a need to discuss aspects of the mid-year report, please contact your child's teacher to arrange at time.

Sibling and OSHClub School Holiday Survey

In the coming days each family will receive an email inviting then to participate in a short survey to assist us with future planning of programs and services. This short survey seeks vital information about future sibling enrolments that enables us to better plan our workforce structures and determine other resource requirements for the next three years. It also has a few questions to determine the level of interest for a school holiday program here at Bell run by our external providers, OSHClub. We would love to get 100% participation to gather accurate data about future Bell needs.

Uniforms

A reminder that the Bell uniform is an important part of our school ethos. Whilst I acknowledge the winter challenge of getting clothes dry, I urge all families to continue doing their best to adhere to the components of the uniform, especially matching the colours of Bell when alternatives need to be worn. Also, I ask parents to ensure children are wearing comfortable and appropriate shoes that support the daily activities inside and out in the yard. In particular, wearing runners or similar style footwear is essential on days when PE classes are scheduled. Please note, hoodies are <u>not</u> part of our school uniform, or the preferred substitutes, when Bell jackets or jumpers are in the wash. Finally, if your child's name is on the clothing, it's more likely to come back when lost.

DET requires a rigorous and immediate two-way communication system between families and schools to ensure daily absences are accounted for during the first session of each day.

Due to the fact that so many Excursion Notices do not make it home, or are misplaced, we have started a trial whereby each time notices are handed to a student, a blank version of the same notice will be emailed home to parents.

Please print another copy if the original is misplaced.

Reminder: 2019 Prep Enrolments

If you have a child ready to commence school in 2019, please ensure you collect a Student Enrolment Form from the office as soon as possible. Please make sure you note the name of your child's <u>kindergarten</u> on the form as this is important information that is required when organising transition days later in the year.

Reminder: Notification of Student Absences

Parents and carers must notify the school of their child's absence, **as soon as possible on the day of absence**, preferably by email direct to the teacher. From Term 3 2018, all Victorian government schools must be notified as soon as practicable on the same day of an unexplained absence, otherwise parents will be contacted – **see SMS Alerts below**.

This DET requirement supports student safety and wellbeing. Schools need to know when and why a child is absent, and parents and carers need to know if their child is not at school when they are expected to be there.

IMPORTANT: SMS ALERTS

A new requirement for all Victorian Government schools is to follow up <u>every unexplained student absence each morning</u>. To facilitate this new process, Bell PS will be sending automated SMS alerts to parents and/or carers of any student marked by their teacher as an "unexplained absence" on that morning.

The SMS will advise you of your child's unexplained absence from school, and ask you to reply immediately with one of the following one or two word explanations only:

unwell
medical appointment
dental appointment
family holiday
parent choice.

If we do not receive a response from you, we are required to follow up with your Emergency Contacts.

To avoiding receiving an unnecessary SMS from us, or your Emergency Contacts being notified, please advise the school <u>before 9.15am</u> if your child/ren will be absent. Your notification can be in the form of an email sent direct to your child/ren's teacher, or a quick phone call to the office.

If you receive an unwarranted SMS alert in the early days of us trialling our new system, please respond anyway. It may take time for this new process to work smoothly. Thank you.

Very Special Request: Missed Calls

Many calls are made to parents each day from teachers, administrators and leadership. Messages are always left where there is a voicemail option. If you notice a MISSED CALL from Bell, PLEASE take the time to wait a minute or three for the message to appear on your phone. (The missed call notification appears immediately, while the message can take a couple of minutes to appear.) Often, the message is an 'advice only' call and it is unnecessary to call back. Also, listening to the full message will allow you to know who to call back, eg: teacher, admin, leadership, if a return call is requested. YOUR HELP WITH THIS REQUEST IS VERY MUCH APPRECIATED BY THE ENTIRE BELL STAFF.


