

Students recognised that we can use specific language. such as Buon Compleanno and Tanti Auguri, to acknowledge a birthday and extend our well wishes.



#### GRADE 2 EXCURSION TO THE INDIGENOUS MURAL

On Friday 13th September, as part of our Indigenous Inquiry unit, Grade 2 students walked to the Indigenous mural on Gilbert Rd to view it up close. With many students living locally, the mural was a familiar scene, however the meaning behind it was something we had lots of questions about. We discovered that the mural shows a timeline in pictures, beginning with a time where indigenous people lived freely on their land, this moved onto invasion and conflict over the land. The timeline then shows images depicting the struggle indigenous people had (and still have) over land rights to contemporary day, with the artwork showcasing significant achievements made within the indigenous community.





The original mural was located in Ruckers Hill in High Street, lorthcote and was moved to its current Gilbert Rd location in 1991.





The original mural was completed in 1984.

In 2014 the 30 year old image was restored as a digital banner with a contemporary addition designed by Gary Saunders.




